You must reapply to be
considered.

Requirements

- Must be enrolled as a student* the semester you are going to be a TA
- Must be in good standing
- Must earn an A or B in the course for which you want to TA
- Overall GPA of at least 2.50
- CS/ECE GPA of at least 3.00
- A clean record with the Dean of Students office (no history of academic misconduct or computer abuse)

* Normally only undergraduate students are hired as TAs through this program. Grad students who have taken the actual course at GT may also be considered

For your first semester of TAing for the College of Computing, you will receive 3 CS elective credit hours plus 1 hour pass/fail credit for the mandatory TA training course.

After that, if rehired, you will be compensated by being paid hourly for up to 18 hours a week.

But that is not your motive.

You want to be a TA because you like helping people learn.

You want to develop your leadership, teamwork, and public speaking skills.

You want to be more involved.

You want to build community.

Plus, you get to know some cool
faculty, and it's a fun job!

Hints

- If you think you want to be a TA.
 - Talk to several TAs in your class
 - Make sure the Course Instructor knows who you are and of your interest
(Hopefully you have already been standing out in the class! Realize the semester has been part of the interview process.)
 - Same for the Head TA
 - Apply early - demonstrate you are decisive and have time management skills

Hints

- We usually have many more applicants than positions so understand that you might not make it just because of the numbers
- Applying for more than one class can be wise to up your chances (although you can TA only 1 max)
